

## Memory – Moments of Remembering and Forgetting

Significant moments are commemorated around the world. Whether chiselled in stone, carved in wood, cast in metal, printed on paper, or reproduced digitally, remembering without the aid of things is almost impossible.

The exhibition offers insight into the fascinating media and practices of remembering. Objects from the museum's collections provide mementos of personal experiences, from birth to death. They also tell of societal events, including wars, upheavals, or colonial encounters, and illustrate how memories are transmitted and appropriated.

At the same time, the exhibition also addresses the aspect of forgetting. Things may also reveal disruptions between the past and the present.

The exhibition invites viewers to reflect on the relevance of the past and encourages them to reflect on their own experiences and memories.
