26 March 2021 – 23 January 2022

What makes the world what it is and what part have humans played in shaping it? The Museum der Kulturen Basel and the Kunstmuseum Basel have got together and are now showing in two exhibitions how humans have applied their knowledge and imagination, and translated their views and perceptions into objects and works of art.

The Museum der Kulturen Basel focusses on "lived worlds". Works from its own collections and those of the Kunstmuseum Basel and the Emanuel Hoffmann Foundation reveal how the creators and makers of these works are intertwined with the worlds they inhabit. It's all about relationships, orientation, and imaginations, and about the traces they leave.

The exhibition at the Kunstmuseum Basel (27.11.2021–24.4.2022) deals with "spiritual worlds" and centres on the human spirit and how it lends meaning to the world through belief and religious imagery.
