## Creators – People and their works

From small brushes to huge dance beams, from delicate feather work to heavy beer pots: 250 objects selected from the museum's collections bear testimony to creativity, ingenuity and skill. But who were the people that wove, moulded, forged or designed these works?

The exhibition introduces viewers to the biographies of well-known artists in words and images, but also sheds light on why many creators have remained mostly anonymous to this day. Collective creativity plays an important role in terms of a group's identity and with regard to social cohesion – in the Americas just as in Oceania. In the exhibition, indigenous artists show how important research on collections is for their communities and their role as artists.
